Are you longing for that super telephoto, but it just isn't in your budget? You can use the digital magnification factor to your advantage! Many digital SLR lenses will yield the results of longer lens. The exact logic is tricky, but each digital camera has it's own multiplication factor. 1.6x is among the most common. If you use a 300mm lens on a camera with a 1.6x digital factor, it is the equivalent of using a 480mm lens on your 35mm camera!
